UK National Champion

The Musto Trophy

This trophy was presented to the class by Nigel Musto of Musto Ltd and is a representation in stainless steel of the boat with mainsail and spinnaker. At the time this was a unique concept. This trophy was presented in 2001 to the Musto Skiff Class as the UK National Championship Perpetual Trophy

World Championship

The Henry Stevenson Memorial Trophy

Henry was the father of one of the class's earliest members, Jamie Stevenson. He was a regular host to competitors from all classes racing in Torbay and helped in the early days of our class with advice and a keen sense of humour!

Following his untimely passing; Jamie asked if he could make a trophy for the class in his father's name. A skilled CNC designer, Jamie produced a 3D model of the basic lines of the boat and had it machined from mahogany.

This trophy was presented in 2004 to the Musto Skiff Class as the World Championship Perpetual Trophy

European Championship

The European Championship Trophy

Following the creation of the Henry Stevenson Trophy by son Jamie, Danny Clark was given the CAD data by Jamie and took this to Fords Dunton Research Centre, where he created a model. This model was used to produce a replica carbon fibre mould (using the same technology and materials used to create car dashboards).

This trophy was presented in 2005 to the Musto Skiff Class as the European Championship Perpetual Trophy
